HOI FU PARENTS RESOURCE CENTRE

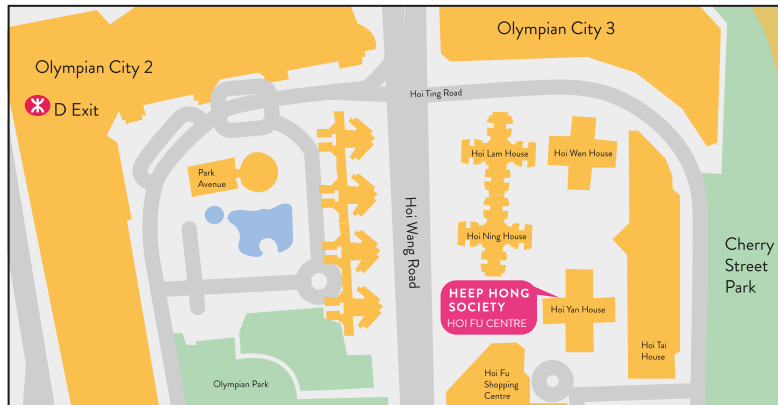
